

Standout Litigator Joshua Blosveren Joins Cohen Ziffer Frenchman & McKenna

Blosveren also achieved a favorable resolution for Cox Enterprises, Inc. and Cox Radio, Inc. in an insurance dispute arising from the infamous Hulk Hogan sex tape scandal.

Cumulatively, Blosveren has obtained hundreds of millions of dollars in insurance recoveries for clients through litigation, arbitration, mediation, and negotiation. He comes to Cohen Ziffer from the litigation boutique Hoguet Newman Regal & Kenney, LLP.

Already in 2025, Cohen Ziffer has achieved a major litigation victory. The firm secured a win for Harman International Industries involving D&O insurance coverage for an alleged "bump-up" payment in an M&A transaction—a case of intense interest for which members of the Cohen Ziffer team were cited as Law360 Legal Lions. The firm has won numerous accolades for its work over the last year, including The National Law Journal's 2024 Elite Trial Lawyers award for insurance. Cohen Ziffer was also shortlisted for the New York Law Journal's 2024 Insurance Litigation Department of the Year award and Business Insurance's 2024 Legal Team of the Year award.

Blossveren, a fellow of the American College of Coverage Counsel and the American Bar Foundation, has received similarly widespread honors for his work. He has been named a Northeast Trailblazer by The American Lawyer, an Elite Boutique Trailblazer by The National Law Journal, and a Litigation Star by Benchmark Litigation. In 2013, he was appointed by the chief judge of the State of New York to the Commercial Division Advisory Council, a permanent group that advises the chief judge on all matters involving the Commercial Division of the State of New York.

Blossveren received his J.D. from New York University School of Law and a B.S., with honors, from Cornell University.
