Robin has served as lead counsel in several courtroom victories that have amounted to billions of dollars in coverage for her clients, including representing New Jersey Transit Corporation in securing a New Jersey state court victory allowing the transportation entity to access up to \$400 million in insurance coverage for property repairs related to Superstorm Sandy. She also represented Givaudan Fragrances Corporation in a New Jersey Supreme Court victory that affirmed Givaudan’s right to seek more than \$500 million in insurance coverage for claims related to environmental damage. Robin was also recognized as the “Litigator of the Week” by *AmLaw Litigation Daily* following her success as lead counsel for Verizon in securing a Delaware Superior Court decision finding that Verizon’s insurers must provide coverage for tens of millions of dollars in legal fees and costs that the company incurred while



successfully defending a \$14 billion lawsuit filed in connection with the spin-off of certain of its directories businesses.
